



The Teal Pumpkin Project is a food allergy awareness campaign from FARE (Food Allergy Research and Education) to promote inclusion of all trick-or-treaters during Halloween season.

How the project works is that food allergy friendly homes, who will be passing out food allergy friendly items/snacks (generally small toys are passed out instead of food items) will place a teal pumpkin (or jack-o-lantern) outside of their home so that people know it's safe for trick-or-treaters with food allergies to visit and trick-or-treat at!
