Troubleshooting Having trouble using the template? Follow these tips.

- Download the Troop T-shirt Templates document to your desktop.
- Right click on the downloaded file, and select Open With, then select Adobe Reader (if you own an upgraded Adobe product, you may alternately select Adobe Reader DC or Adobe Reader Pro).
- If you see a URL in the top menu bar upon opening the document, the template file will not allow you to interact and you will need to complete some additional troubleshooting steps.

- 1. Open Adobe Acrobat app or software on your PC and select Edit > Preferences in the top menu.
- 2. Click Internet in the left panel of the Preferences menu, then select Internet Settings in the main screen.
- 3. Select the Programs tab.
- 4. Click Manage Add-Ons and select Adobe Reader in the list of add-ons. You may need to show the Run Without Permissions options to find Adobe Reader in the list. Once Adobe Reader appears in the list, click the row to select.
- 5. Click the Disable button to ensure PDFs won't be opened in a browser.
- 6. Close all PDF files and try opening the file with Adobe Reader again.
