

Super Girl Scout Award

After earning at least 80 points, download your Super Girl Scout certificate to showcase your achievement. Super Girl Scout Award runs from October 1 – September 30 of each year.

Action Items: 10 Points Each	Points Earned
Cookie Program: Participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Program. A Girl Scout is participating if they are registered and selling cookies.	
Outdoor/Overnight Experience: Participate in an outdoor or overnight experience.	
Girl Scout Engagement: Participate in a Girl Scout troop meeting, event, or activity at least 8 times.	
Recruitment: Invite a non-Girl Scout friend to a Girl Scout activity or event, earn the Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) Recruitment Ranger patch , or assist with a troop, service unit, or GSCTX hosted recruitment event.	
Spring Renewal: Renew your Girl Scout membership during spring renewal.	
Fall Product Program: Participate in the Fall Product Program or complete a financial literacy badge.	
Petals, Badges, and Awards: Earn at least 5 badges, 2 Journeys, or work towards your Bronze, Silver, or Gold Award.	
Do Something Fun: Earn a patch through a <u>council patch program</u> or attend a fun troop or service unit hosted event such as an ice cream social, hike, camping or backyard campout, field trip, bridging, investiture/rededication, or end of year awards ceremony.	
Community Service: Complete a community service project or perform a service to Girl Scouts. Service to Girl Scouts examples include leading an investiture, rededication, or bridging ceremony, helping out with a younger Girl Scout troop, assisting your service unit at an event, or volunteering at the council level.	
Leadership: Earn a Girl Scout leadership award such as the Journey Summit Award, My Promise, My Faith Pin, Girl Scout Safety Award, or Cookie Family Entrepreneur Pin. Juniors can also earn the Junior Aide Award. Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors can visit the GSCTX Scholarships and Other Awards page for more ideas.	
Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Events: Attend a DEIB event hosted by your troop, service unit, GSCTX, other Girl Scout council, local museum, library, or community organization or complete a GSCTX , GSUSA , or other council multicultural patch program.	
Share Your Story: <u>Submit a story</u> about one of your Girl Scout activities or post your story to a public Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, or TikTok page and mention @gsctx or tag #gsctx.	
Volunteer Toolkit (VTK): Visit VTK with a caregiver or troop leader to view available petals, badges, and Journeys and plan what you would like to complete this membership year.
