Position Summary: This position is responsible for providing input and feedback to improve the Super Girl Scout, Super Troop, and Super Service Unit Awards requirements and processes in collaboration with Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) Volunteer Strategy Department.

Accountability: Appointed by and accountable to the appropriate GSCTX staff members for a one-year term (March 1 – February 28).

Responsibilities:

- Attends virtual committee meetings in March, April, and May.
- Surveys the volunteers within your service unit/area to assess sentiment and opinion on specific Super Awards issues pending before the committee.
- Provides feedback to improve the Super Awards processes and requirements.
- Advocates for the Super Awards in your service unit and area.

Position Commitments:

- At least two years of troop, service unit, and/or council volunteer experience or equivalent, preferably in a leadership position.
- Current knowledge of Super Awards processes and requirements.
- Effective communication skills, both orally and written.
- Ability to make a commitment to the philosophy of Girl Scouting, both nationally and locally.
- Ability to effectively interact, work, and collaborate with people of various cultural backgrounds and promote an environment of inclusivity.
- Be a registered adult member of GSUSA, have a current eligible criminal background check on file at GSCTX, and be in good standing with GSCTX.
