Position Summary: This position is responsible for reviewing and approving Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) and Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) award nominations in collaboration with the other Volunteer Awards Committee members and the GSCTX Volunteer Strategy Department.

Accountability: Appointed by and accountable to the appropriate GSCTX staff members for a one-year term (March 1 – February 28).

Responsibilities:

- Attends virtual committee meetings in March, April, and May.
- Provides input and feedback regarding annual council and national award nominations.
- Provides feedback to improve awards guidelines and processes.
- Advocates for council and national awards and nominations in your area.

Position Commitments:

- At least two years of troop, service unit, and/or council volunteer experience or equivalent, preferably in a leadership position.
- Have a current knowledge of service unit, council, and national awards, including the guidelines, requirements, and processes.
- Preferred: Previously received service unit, council, and/or national awards and/or served as service unit volunteer recognitions coordinator.
- Effective communication skills, both orally and written.
- Ability to make a commitment to the philosophy of Girl Scouting, both nationally and locally.
- Ability to effectively interact, work, and collaborate with people of various cultural backgrounds and promote an environment of inclusivity.
- Be a registered adult member of GSUSA, have a current eligible criminal background check on file at GSCTX, and be in good standing with GSCTX.
