

Girl Scouts of Central Texas Service Unit Recognitions Committee Member

Position Summary: This position is responsible for assisting with formal and informal recognition of adult volunteers and youth members in the assigned service unit throughout the year for their outstanding Girl Scout achievements in collaboration with other Service Unit (SU) Recognitions Committee members.

Accountability: Appointed for the assigned service unit and accountable to service unit leadership team or other appropriate Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) staff members. This position is appointed for a one-year term limit and will be reviewed annually.

Responsibilities:

- Works with the other SU Recognitions Committee members to brainstorm ways to informally recognize adult volunteers and youth members, make an informal recognition plan for the year, and enact it.
- Collaborates with the other SU Recognitions Committee members to review service unit award nominations, select final recipients, and plan and host an annual service unit recognition event or events.
- Provides input and feedback to improve service unit recognition efforts for the assigned service unit.

Position Commitments:

- Effective communication skills, both orally and written.
- Ability to make a commitment to the philosophy of Girl Scouting, both nationally and locally.
- Ability to effectively interact, work, and collaborate with people of various cultural backgrounds and promote an environment of inclusivity.
- Be a registered adult member of GSUSA, have a current eligible criminal background check on file at GSCTX, and be in good standing with GSCTX.
